Primary School Programs

With so many boys and girls enjoying a team sports atmosphere and taking an interest in netball we have been overwhelmed by interest from Primary schools across Frankston and the Mornington Peninsula to have us come out and introduce netball to their younger students, or work on more advanced skills and drill with their older students, with the aim to increase participation levels at local clubs across the region.

Seaford Park Primary introduced their 40 preps to one of our pop up Net Set Go sessions at lunchtime which was a huge hit, as the kids learnt some new skills and many booked into weekly net set go sessions at their local association to continue to develop their love of netball.

At Tootgarook Primary we have been working in the year 5 and 6 PE classes over a 3 week block where we saw massive improvements in the students skills,



and gave the PE teacher some new ideas for future classes prompting their students to run their own netball games at lunchtime. Eastbourne Primary booked us in for an 8 week lunchtime engagement program offering fun netball games and drills to their year 2-4 students where we also supplied balls and bibs for future netball programs in the school.
